We welcome contributions from community members to be featured on our blog. To ensure submissions reflect our organization's mission and values, please review the following guidelines before submitting:

1. Relevance

- Articles should relate to ECCAO's focus, e.g., community development, education, health, environment, etc.
- Submissions should share knowledge, experiences, or insights that could benefit or inspire our readers.

2. Respectful & Inclusive Content

- Keep language professional, respectful, and accessible to a wide audience.
- **Do not include** offensive, discriminatory, or inflammatory content.
- Articles **must avoid** promotion of religious, political, or partisan views.

3. Originality

- Submissions must be original work (not previously published elsewhere, unless the author has permission to republish).
- Properly cite and credit any sources, data, or images used.

4. Non-Commercial

- Articles should not advertise or promote specific businesses, products, or services.
- References to tools, organizations, or resources are welcome if they serve an educational purpose.

5. Format & Length

- Suggested length: 600–1,000 words.
- Include a clear title, short summary, and author name.
- Optional: up to 2–3 images (with proper permissions).

6. Editorial Review

- Our editorial team reserves the right to edit submissions for clarity, grammar, length, and alignment with our mission.
- Not all submissions will be published, but we will notify authors of the outcome.

7. Tone & Style

- Write in a clear, engaging, and informative style.
- Use plain language—avoid jargon unless explained.
- Focus on adding value to the community.
